#### Pagham Parish Council October 2025

Earlier this month Jess Brown-Fuller, our elected MP, held her first surgery in the village hall. For 2 hours on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> September she was kept fully occupied listening to residents' comments and questions. Hopefully this will be a regular consultation opportunity.

Last quarter I wrote of the forthcoming reorganisation of local councils and the creation of Unitary authorities across the whole of East and West Sussex. The consultations and implications of the loss of the district level of councils as they are merged with county councils are much debated and the financial and governmental implications calculated.

PPC has had its debates and forwarded the conclusions that councillors came to as they looked at possibilities. The choices of 1 or 2 unitary divisions are the possibilities.

PPC advised that they believed 2 councils of under 500k constituents would serve Sussex best. A single council for almost 1M people would dilute the ability of people to influence decisions too much. There being too few councillors in the single unitary body to service properly the large number of parish councillors and efficiently reflect their views. The intention being for Parishes to have more input in order to genuinely influence decisions with their local knowledge. Merging into a single council would lead to

services being streamlined in order to reduce budgets. The loss of services would be the most likely outcome in a large overburdening single council. It was also felt that splitting county

council work loads in two would ensure a more efficient transition.

The local consultations are now closed and the opening of consultation with central government will begin in November.

In the mean time a financial budget has been prepared to identify the likely costs and savings that the potential changes might

accrue.

The pond in Pagham is an emotive subject, but despite continued work being ongoing the developer who owns the land has still not come forward with funds to restore it to a proper state. Councillor Jan Behr is hoping to resolve this situation in the future. We all wish her more power to her endeavours.

#### LOVELY LEMON CHEESECAKE

#### **Base**

4oz/125g crushed digestive biscuits 1 level dessertspoon sugar 2oz/50g margarine, melted Grated rind of 1 lemon.



Mix together and press into 8" loose bottom tin. Chill for 30 mins

#### **Filling**

1 small tin evaporated milk ½ lemon jelly dissolved in ¼ pint boiling water Juice of 1 lemon 165gm tub Philadelphia cheese Whip evaporated milk in bowl and beat in cheese. Whisk in lemon juice then stir in cooled jelly. Pour into base and leave to set.
